MULTI-ENTRY FIRE ESCAPE CHUTE INSTALLED AT PLANET GODREJ

Planet Godrej, the 48-storey residential towers by Godrej Properties Limited at Mahalaxmi, Mumbai, have recently installed the Ingstrom Fire Escape Chute, an emergency exit that permits rapid, mass evacuation from high-rise structures during life threatening emergencies.

In times when residential towers are getting taller, this comes as a welcome relief.

Some of the benefits claimed by the manufacturers of the Fire Escape chute are evacuating people at the rate of 30 people per minute, descent from 50 storey in approximately 100 seconds, access to chute available from every floor, protects evacuees from fire effects and suitability for people of all ages and physical condition.

Explaining the rationale behind this initiative, Milind Korde, Managing Director, Godrej Properties Ltd., said "We are convinced that this emergency exit product will add value to the existing facilities and our customers can feel safer. We aim to set benchmarks for facilities in our projects and this is an extension of that process."
